

CAP LOCK REVOLVER SPECIFICATIONS

TRADITIONAL CAP LOCK REVOLVER

1. A revolver fitted with any original production type fore sight and fixed 'notch' type rear sight.
2. The firearm must be of the 'cap and ball' type, i.e.; cylinder chambers loaded manually from the front, using percussion caps that are fitted to nipples.
3. Bore size permitted is 0.30 inch (7.6 mm) through to 0.75 inch (19.05 mm).

MODERN CAP LOCK REVOLVER

- 1 A revolver fitted with adjustable sights of any type.
- 2 The firearm must be of the 'cap and ball' type, i.e.; cylinder chambers loaded manually from the front, using percussion caps that are fitted to nipples.
- 3 Bore size permitted is 0.30 inch (7.6 mm) through to 0.75 inch (19.05 mm).
